Does everybody meet this minimum mobility requirement?

What happens if one of the guests declined the policy?

If the policy is declined, you can still make the booking but they will need to request a GP letter stating that the person in question is fit to travel. The letter must state in the GP's professional opinion, that the guest is able to undertake a holiday at sea without assistance other than in an emergency situation.

Single travellers with walking aids

For any single traveller requesting to bring a wheelchair, scooter or any type or walking aid (for example Zimmer frame, Rollator) on board, a GP letter is also required stating that they are fit to travel. The letter must state in the GP's professional opinion, that the guest is able to undertake a holiday at sea UNACCOMPANIED without assistance other than in an emergency situation. GP letters must be provided in order to complete this booking.
