

HEBRIDEAN ESCAPE

14th - 21st MAY 2020

Arriving on the incredible Hebridean Isles, you really will feel like you have escaped from it all as you explore breath taking coasts and countryside, fascinating history and unique island cultures on this, quite literally, breath of fresh air tour.

Itinerary

Thursday Day 1

Following our morning door to door service we head north for our overnight stay, The Winnock Hotel, Drymen.

Today, we travel to Berneray, reputedly one of HRH Prince Charles' favourite destinations. We board the ferry to Leverburgh on the Isle of Harris and visit St Clement's Church, Rodel. We visit the Isle of Scalpay and admire its lovely waterfront villages before making our way to our final destination of the day, Stornoway, where we settle into our hotel for two nights.

Monday Day 5

Today we enjoy a tour of the island's fantastic scenery. Lewis is the largest and most populated of the Western Isles, although it remains refreshingly unspoilt and uncrowded. Home to some of the most important seabird colonies in the UK, the Isle of Lewis is a haven to all forms of wildlife. During our circular tour, we visit Carloway Broch, an ancient Iron Age fortification and enjoy a visit to the mystic Calanais Visitor Centre where we will be able to see the Callanish Standing Stones, one of the best preserved megalithic sites in the whole of Scotland. We also visit Gearrannan Blackhouse Village and step back in time as we experience the way of life in a typical crofting township of the 19th century.

Tuesday Day 6

This morning we enjoy some free time to relax and explore the town of Stornoway before boarding the early afternoon ferry to Ullapool where we continue to the Ben Wyvis Hotel, Strathpeffer, arriving in time for dinner.

Wednesday Day 7

We leave the beauty of northern Scotland and head south to our overnight hotel, Gretna Hall Hotel, Gretna Green.



HEALTH CONDITIONS

- Are you travelling:
 - against the advice of a medical practitioner, or
 - for the purpose of obtaining medical treatment.
- Have you been given a terminal prognosis.
- Are you receiving or awaiting treatment for any bodily injury, illness or disease as a hospital day case or in-patient.
- If you are on prescribed medication, are your medical condition(s) stable and well controlled.

- Is taking prescribed medication.
- Has or has had any medical condition still requiring periodic review.
- Is awaiting any tests, treatment, investigation, referral or the results of these.

You must notify the Towergate Medical Line immediately of any changes in medical circumstances arising between the date the policy is issued and the time of departure for the trip. You may have to pay an additional premium to cover your medical conditions. This applies to all destinations including trips solely within the United Kingdom (being defined as England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland and the Isles of Scilly).
