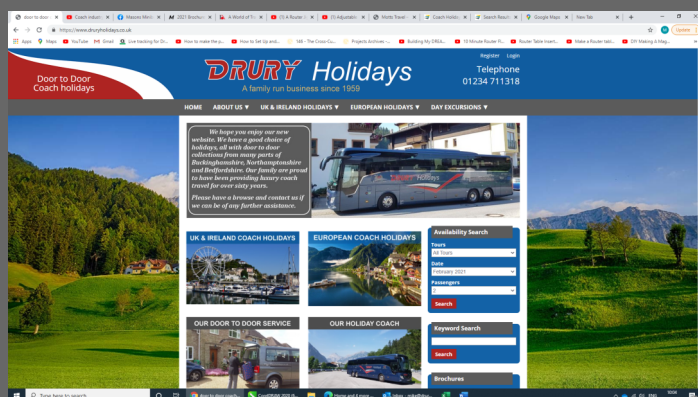

SOCIAL DISTANCING ON OUR COACH

We have been asked since the governments roadmap was issued if we will still be operating the social distancing on our coach. The rules, once we are allowed to travel, will be that until at least June 21st we should wear a mask / visor or have a valid medical reason for not using a face covering (PLEASE INFORM US BEFORE TRAVELLING IF YOU ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WEAR A COVERING). Where possible keep a distance of 2 metres on the coach with anybody outside of your bubble. On occasions it may be necessary due to seating arrangement to be within 2 metres. This is within the law.
