HOW TO BOOK YOUR HOLIDAY

Once you have selected your holiday, please call our office on 01234 711318 and you will be notified of all available seats. Once you have chosen your seat, please complete and return the booking form enclosed with this brochure and send it to our office address. We will hold the seats and room provisionally for 7 days.

SEAT ALLOCATION

On occasions it may be necessary to re allocate seats on the tour coach. We will always try to accommodate requests and you will be notified in writing of any changes. Please note single travellers are not guaranteed a seat to themselves.

PAYMENT

Holiday payments can be made by cheque or bank transfer (details on page 3 of booking form). Cheques should be made payable to Drury Holidays LTD.

On receipt of the completed booking form and deposit we will process the booking and post or email the confirmation back to you. The confirmation will indicate the balance to pay and the date to send payment by (8 weeks before travel). Please note no reminder will be sent. Please enclose the remittance slip when sending balance cheques or making a bank transfer.

Around a week before travel you will receive your travel pack which should include travel tickets with your pick up time from home highlighted, luggage labels with feeder destination printed (for coach driver use) and printed itinerary booklet.

ELECTRIC SCOOTERS / LUGGAGE

We are unable to accommodate electric scooters within our door to door service. Please note we are only able to accommodate one electric fold up scooter per tour no larger than a medium size suitcase. This must be pre booked and delivered direct to the coach, and an able bodied person must be available to load/unload into the coach lockers for the duration of the holiday. We regret that we are unable to lift awkward items or any luggage item weighing more than 18kg. Fold up wheelchairs and walkers will be accommodated, please inform us if you wish to bring one in the special requests section of the booking form. 1 medium size suitcase per person will be allowed weighing no more than 18kg. A small rucksack size hand luggage bag may also be taken onboard the coach.

PASSPORTS

You will require a passport with a minimum of 6 months remaining validity for any overseas holiday. Please contact our office if in doubt.

SPRING IN CARDIGAN BAY, WALES

16th - 20th March 2026





A spring tour to Cardigan Bay. Take in the natural beauty of the Pembrokeshire Coast, visit Britain's smallest city, St Davids, home of the patron saint of Wales, and learn about the wool heritage of the country at the National Wool Museum.

Itinerary

Monday Day 1

After our door to door service we travel to Wales, arriving at The Cliff Hotel and Spa in the late afternoon.

Tuesday Day 2

After a leisurely breakfast, we journey through the Teifi Valley to the National Wool Museum. The museum shares the story of this trade. After our visit, we return through the valley to Cardigan where we enjoy free time to explore at leisure. The town's main landmarks are the Cardigan Castle plus the 19th century Guildhall, built in Gothic architectural style.

Wednesday Day 3

This morning, we travel south to the small seaside resort of Saundersfoot. We have time to look around before we continue to Tenby. Regarded as one of the prettiest resorts in Wales, Tenby is renowned for its lovely golden beaches and picturesque harbour. Explore the old town walls, interesting little side streets and alleyways.

Thursday Day 4

After breakfast, we enjoy a scenic drive along the coast to the smallest city in Britain, St Davids. We enjoy free time at leisure with the option of browsing the small independent stores, exploring St Davids Cathedral or visiting the Oriel y Parc Gallery. We return to the hotel early afternoon for a light buffet lunch followed by free time to relax at the hotel. 

Wednesday Day 3

After a leisurely breakfast we travel the short distance to Penrhyn Castle and Gardens. The dominating stone façade

hides more than just its internal redbrick construction. Built in the early 19th century, its formidable architecture, opulent interiors and fine art collection lean on a long history of sugar and slate fortunes,



social unrest and the longest-running industrial dispute in British history.

Thursday Day 4

We enjoy a free day to explore Llandudno. Take the tram up the Great Orme, enjoy a vintage bus ride (price not included), or simply stroll along the prom.

Friday Day 5

After breakfast we journey home, meeting our door to door service in the afternoon.



Wednesday Day 3

After a leisurely breakfast this morning we enjoy free time in Chester. This historic city offers lots to see and do. Explore the unique 'Rows' of two-tiered shops or take a stroll around the City Walls. Meander down to the River Dee and maybe purchase lunch in a riverside pub. Later, we enjoy a sightseeing boat cruise with commentary about the local area and its history.

Thursday Day 4

This morning we make our way to Port Sunlight where we enjoy a guided tour of Port Sunlight Village. Built by William Hesketh Lever for his factory workers and named after his famous Sunlight soap this is a superb example of how life used to be. We return to the hotel in the afternoon for a Cream Tea — including tea/coffee, scones, clotted cream, butter and jam.
